White Wines

- 1. Pinot Grigio, Prima Gusto, Italy** £13.00
Light straw in colour with a healthy hue, this is a lively, fresh & frisky wine, with a clean, crunchy green apple bouquet, dry smooth palate, & complementary bracing acidity.
- 2. Chardonnay, Les Beauchamps, France** £14.50
Ripe with pear & pineapple flavours, this chardonnay is smooth & luscious with a wonderfully long finish
- 3. Pinot Grigio/Torrontes, Zuccardo, Argentina** £14.50
Brilliant straw yellow colour with green hues & medium intensity. Fruity opulence & floral with notes of pears, pineapples & bananas. Fresh, crisp & lively this medium bodied white wine has excellent harmony in the mouth
- 4. Viognier, Con Sur, Chile** £15.00
Dressed in the beautiful medium golden colour characteristic of this variety. Sweet notes of Apricots, citrics & peaches anticipate final hints of azahar flower notes. Fresh & lively in mouth, this viognier is concentrated, tasty, full and savoury.
- 5. Sauvignon Blanc, Dashwood, New Zealand** £16.00
Great marlborough sauvignon with cut grass & green pepper aromas- crisp & vibrant gooseberry fruit on the palate, with a slight off-dry finish
- 6. Pouilly Fume, Le Brun, France** £22.50
This is clean & pure with character & length. Gooseberry fruit & box-wood flavours pair with flinty notes

Red Wines

- 7. Chianti, veduta, Italy** £14.50
Luscious flavours of ripe berry & dark morello cherry are supported on the palate by a backbone of firm tannins
- 8. Cotes Du Rhone, Berthete, France** £15.00
A fruity, spicy nose gives way to a palate of ripe berries, white pepper, hints of anise & subtle tannins
- 9. Rioja, Glorioso Crianza, Spain** £17.00
Medium bodied and smooth with red fruits & vanilla combining with lovely warm soft tannins
- 10. Pinotage, Tukulu, South Africa** £17.00
Intense in colour & flavour, this superb wine is a smoky masterpiece. Components include sweet strawberry, liquorice & vanilla flavours, while soft tannins make it wonderfully approachable in youth
- 11. Bordeaux, Chateau Amarande, France** £17.50
A Merlot- dominated blend, the deep bouquet is of vanilla & pine. In the mouth; a round & supple fusion of flavours that are fantastically balanced, with a structure that is not overwhelmingly tannic

12. **Pinot Noir, Matahiwi, New Zealand** £22.50
 Showing dark plum and raspberry on the nose, with fragrant fresh hay characters. On the medium-bodied palate, it is soft & round, with a hint of spicy smoky oak and a long finish

ROSE

13. **Pinot Grigio, Trebbiano Pink, Italy** £14.00
 A light pink coloured rose with aromas of fresh red berries, hints of mint notes balanced by good vivacity!
14. **Cotes du Provence, Cabaret, France** £16.50
 A deep- coloured, robust red with fresh cherry fruit aromas, medium body and concentrated, spicy plummy flavours.

Sparkling & Champagne

15. **Prosecco, Ca'Rosa, Italy** £17.00
 A fizzy fruit bombshell. Light-weight & gently aromatic, with crisp, delicate fresh apple flavours
16. **NV Champagne, H. Blin, France** £35.00
 Dry, rich, fresh and fruity with the flowery elegance of ripe Pinot Meunier. Well-balanced with good, lively acidity

Honeysuckle and pear aromas lead on to a refreshing, crisp & dry palate | £4.25 | £14.50 |

Lime, peaches & gooseberries on the nose, with a grapefruit & crispy capsicum palate & a soft tropical finish | £4.25 | £14.50 |
| 19. | Sediba Shiraz – South Africa
Plush with ripe plum and cherry fruits, the soft palate has an earthy edge with a spicy, savoury twang | £4.25 | £14.50 |
| 20. | Moon Valley Merlot – Chile
Ripe flavours of plums, redcurrants, mocha & all spice | £4.25 | £14.50 |

Many of our wines arrive with screwcaps or 'Stelvin' closures; more and more forward-looking winemakers are choosing this method of closure, as it eliminates the risk of cardboardy cork taint. While realising that traditionalists may find the absence of a cork surprising in wines of this quality, we welcome the assurance they bring of taint-free wine.
